

Renovation & Kitchen Expansion

This 2-story addition allowed for a significant expansion (approximately 350 square feet) of the homeowner's kitchen area as well as a garage/work shop below. With the additional space came expansive work areas, much-improved traffic flow as well as much-needed room for additional cabinetry, appliances, and countertops. In addition to the kitchen expansion, this project included cosmetic renovations to the family's great room including energy-efficient window replacement.

For perspective, note the great room's arched window in both the BEFORE photo to the right as well as the after photo above it. Both photos were taken from approximately the same location. The new addition opens up from where the glass-paned deck doors once stood and beyond the exterior wall behind the original kitchen sink.

The kitchen photos on this page were all taken from space that was previously the deck. The photo to the right clearly shows the openness created by the addition—providing easy access to the dining room (far right) as well as the great room (straight ahead). Work on the great room (below) included new windows and casings, raised flooring, new trim, refinished beams with reflective ceiling lights.



This BEFORE and after comparison clearly shows the new 2-story addition which replaced the original deck. A portion of the new deck (not part of this project) can be seen on the far left of the after photo.
