
PROJECT DESCRIPTION


This renovation and two-story addition project included an expanded new kitchen, great room, full basement, and master suite, as well as replacing virtually all existing electric and plumbing throughout the home. The new, custom kitchen was designed with a large 9-foot island, quartz counters, a wet bar, and plenty of much needed storage space. The kitchen expands into the new great room lined with beautiful wooden windows and hardwood flooring. The hardwood flooring throughout the original first floor was completely refinished to match beautifully with that of the new addition. To access the new 2nd floor area you initially walk up the original staircase which now splits on the first landing-one set of stairs going to the original bedrooms and a new set leading to the new master suite that includes a spacious bedroom, bath, and walk- in closet complete with custom shelving. Adjacent to the suite is a new laundry room.






NEW FLOOR PLAN






