ou are finally ready to do that remodeling project you have wanted to do. How do you ensure that you aren't wasting time and money? Two common causes of stress and problems are poor communication and incorrect expectations. The better you communicate with your contractor and the better you both understand each other's expectation. the easier time you will have with your project. #### **How much will this cost?**

Seems simple enough but many people take for granted changes or delays and how they affect the cost. If they don't have this material, how much will it cost to replace it with the new choice? Will delaying the project till after the first of the year cause the cost to go up? Does the contractor have a system in place to stay on budget? Do they guarantee their price? What happens if it goes over budget?

### Who is my point of contact?

The person who signed the contract with you may not be the person you are dealing with during the project. Who will that person be? What is their cell phone and email? When can I get in touch with them?

### What happens if something goes wrong?
