SANIFLO toilets can be installed in places where conventional plumbing is difficult or impossible to do so. Thanks to its unique macerating system, a SANIFLO toilet can be installed almost anywhere without compromising the building's foundation.

With SANIFLO, you can install a full or half bath. Matching sinks are available. The technology is

applicable to residential or commercial applications.

SANIFLO toilets have been well accepted in Europe since the 1960s and gaining in popularity in the United States for more than 15 years. Even if you haven't heard of them, chances are you've used one!

How it Works

Traditional plumbing systems use gravity and large diameter pipe work to pump waste. Often, it is this requirement that makes it difficult—if not impossible—to add the desired additional bathroom. SANIFLO resolves this issue by using small-diameter pipe that can run virtually anywhere, across floor joists or in narrow floor or ceiling spaces. This prevents the need for major construction to accommodate the traditional plumbing operation.

Another way in which SANIFLO toilets differ from conventional plumbing systems is that they use a macerator, grinder and pump to process waste and deliver it to a standard sewer system (or related). The macerator and grinder work together (in stages) to ensure that even items that are accidentally introduced to the system are properly processed. (Discuss your usage and application with a qualified plumbing contractor.)

SANIFLO is safe, sanitary and reliable. All SANIFLO products are designed to pump waste into a city sewer, septic tank or soil stack. Maintenance is not required but a de-scaler can be used to clean the system to ensure peak performance.

Most SANIFLO products require 115 volts and must be plugged into a GFI receptacle. A dedicated circuit is not required. Some models require 220/440 volts and must be hard wired. Qualified plumbers will help you select the product that is right for your unique application.

Can you install SANIFLO yourself? Although it sounds uncomplicated because major construction is not required, installing SANIFLO still requires complex connections to sewer (or septic/soil stacks) and electrical hook ups.
