To make room for the new addition, two previous additions in the rear of the home (a laundry and family room – pictured above) were sacrificed.



Comparing the before and after interior shots, it's easy to see the openness and improved traffic flow made possible by the home expansion. Adding to that spacious theme, note the expansive entry ways leading into the original home.



As depicted in the plans (lower left), the addition houses the new kitchen as well as a spacious dining room both of which offer great views of the lush surroundings. Although a single addition, the twin dormers coming off the original roofline (as seen in the aerial photo upper left) allow for cathedral ceilings in both the kitchen and dining areas.
